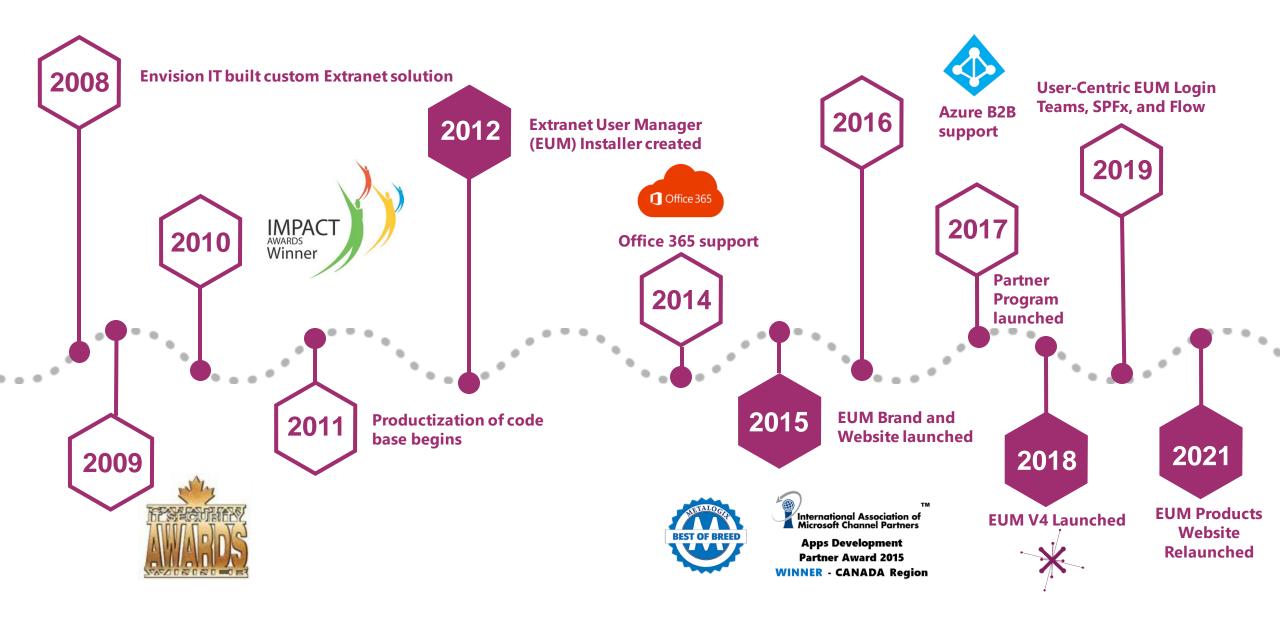



Request Files


- Ask colleagues and external guest users to upload files to a folder
- Uploaders can only see their own content
- Single link can be used for many uploaders






Unstructured Extranets with Microsoft 365 External Sharing

- External Sharing in Microsoft 365 strongly supports ad-hoc collaboration
- Sharing documents with a few to a few dozen external people
- Secure Link sharing to sites, libraries, and documents
 - Anyone with the link (Anonymous)
 - People in your Organization
 - People with existing access
 - Specific people



Top 5 External Sharing Configuration Tips


- 1. Consider <u>all</u> sharing use cases when setting your Organization-level external sharing policies
- 2. Do not be afraid of the "Anyone" link sharing, you can limit access on a site by site basis
- 3. Please do not skip over the additional sharing settings:
 - Limit sharing by domain
 - Guests must sign in using the same account invitations were sent to (this should be checked!)
 - Verification code must reauthenticate in x days
- 4. Enforce a default link setting on a site by site basis
 - We recommend People with Existing Access
- 5. Consider ways to templatize your sites so your external sharing structure stays consistent




Scenario One – Financial Reporting

- Parent organization with dozens of subsidiaries
 - Publicly traded
 - Subsidiaries are their own legal entities with independent financial reporting
- Monthly, quarterly, annual, and audit reporting packages
 - Strict schedules to collect, review, and roll up
- Finance staff at subsidiaries may be responsible for one or multiple subsidiaries




Scenario Two – Distributing and Tracking Emergency Plans

- Emergency Preparedness Response Plans (EPRP) to Community First Responders along river systems
 - Police, fire, hospital, municipal
- Documents authored in SharePoint Online and Published to secure Azure Website
- Email notifications are sent out to first responders to notify them of a new EPRP version
- Power BI dashboard provides visibility to who has downloaded documents







Scenario Three – Engineering Drawing Package Review

- Engineering 2D and 3D CAD drawings to be reviewed and approved by customers
- SAP integration
- Automation of drawing package preparation
- Workflow for approvals
 - Internal engineering approval may be required first
 - Customer notification and approval
 - Reminder notifications
 - Approval completion updates SAP order status
- Ability for customer to upload annotated or additional documents

 - Up to date insurance certificates
 - Signed code of conduct form
- Simple portal to upload documents
- Auto-tagging based on logged in supplier
